## INSURANCE

Orthodontic insurance coverage is a wonderful way to help cover the cost of orthodontic treatment. You may have dental insurance benefits from your employer that covers a portion of your orthodontic treatment fees. We will help you claim your maximum benefit.

Please be aware that all professional services are charged directly to the patient. You are responsible for your entire fee. The insurance company may or may not reimburse you for part of the fee.

### *Coverage*

There are many different policies used in employee benefit packages. Your employer chose the specific benefits offered in your dental / orthodontic insurance plan. Unlike medical insurance, most dental insurance companies pay only a portion of the orthodontic fee. Also they usually have a fixed lifetime maximum benefit.

There may also be a deductible amount. Insurance companies will usually provide an initial amount to cover part of your down payment, and then provide monthly, quarterly, or annual payments over a number of months of treatment.

Since every insurance company sells different policies, it is impossible for us to predict exactly what is covered by your policy. If you have any questions about coverage, please contact your insurance agent, your union representative, or your employer's "Health Benefit" section at work

### *Filing a Claim*

We will provide you with a financial expense plan for you to pay us directly. Some insurance companies require a "Pre-authorization or Pre-determination" of orthodontic benefits to tell you if and how they will pay toward the treatment fee. Before any insurance form can be submitted for pre-determination, we will need to take Orthodontic Records (molds of the teeth, x-rays, photographs, etc.) and a complete a diagnosis and treatment plan.

We will assist you with your insurance by filing your claims for you. We ask that you provide us with a copy of your dental insurance card, and the subscriber information. All insurance checks will be sent directly to you.
